Dr. Jeromin became a board-certified veterinary dermatologist in 1993 after a residency with Dr. Patrick Breen,

Diplomate ACVD, Cincinnati, Ohio. Her grant-funded research dealt with Sebaceous Adenitis in the Standard Poodle. She is an adjunct professor at Case Western Reserve University College of Medicine, past president of the Cleveland Academy of Veterinary Medicine, a member of the Cleveland Dermatological Society, American Veterinary Medical Association, Ohio Veterinary Medical Association, Summit County Veterinary Medical Association, Ohio Veterinary Medical Association's liaison committee with the Ohio State Board of Pharmacy, and is a member of AVMA Council on Biologics and Therapeutic Agents.
